Virtual colloquium at Aarhus University

The Forum for Renaissance Studies and the project Cultural Encounter as Precondition for European Identity (funded by the Carlsberg Foundation) invites you to join us for the colloquium Meaningful Memories.

The colloquium takes as its point of departure the volume *Meaningful Memories. A cultural memory perspective on humanist interaction with the past* (available at www.njrs.dk/njrs_17_2020.htm).

The seven contributors apply cultural memory studies to explore how memory as a concept can shed light on the use made by renaissance humanist writers of the classical as well as other pasts. Contributions discuss, among other matters, memory as passive or active praxis; as including or excluding praxis; and the relationship between sources and contexts of interpretation as well as how selection, interpretation, presentation and preservation affect this relationship.

At the colloquium, Prof. em. Minna Skaftte Jensen will discuss with the volume contributors what may (or may not) be gained from applying a cultural memory framework to the study of how the renaissance humanists understood the past and its implication for their present day.

It is not a prerequisite for participation to have read the volume.
